Nemo me impune lacessit is the <u>Latin</u> motto of the <u>Order of the Thistle</u> and of three <u>Scottish regiments</u>

of the British Army.

The motto also appears, in conjunction with the <u>collar</u> of the Order of the Thistle, in later versions of the <u>Royal coat of arms</u> of the <u>Kingdom of Scotland</u> and subsequently in the version of the <u>Royal coat of arms of the United Kingdom</u> used in Scotland.

It is often translated as *No one attacks me with impunity*, or rendered in <u>Scots</u> as *Wha daur meddle wi' me?*

It is also alternatively translated into English as *No one can harm me unpunished*.
